# ***Echo Sweater***

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## MATERIALS

### Scheepjes Woolwise

(100% Recycled Superwash Merino Wool; 100g/200m)

760 Woodland x 6 (6: 7: 8: 9: 10) balls  
addiClick 3.25mm, 3.75mm, 4mm circular

knitting needles

Stitch holders

4 locking stitch markers

## GAUGE/TENSION

22 stn en 30 rijen in tr met 4 mm naalden meten  
10 x 10 cm.

## ABBREVIATIONS

[ ] number of sts on a given round/row

**beg** begin(ning)

**dec** decrease

**inc** increase

**k** knit

**kwise** knitwise

**m** stitch marker(s)

**M1** make 1 st: to inc by 1 st by picking up horizontal bar bet 2 sts with left needle, then knit into back of this st

**p** purl

**p2tog** purl 2 sts tog to dec by 1 st: insert needle pwise into first 2 sts and purl them tog (right leaning dec)

**patt(s)** pattern(s)

**pm** place stitch marker(s)

**pwise** purlwise

**rep(s)** repeat(s)

**RS** right side

**st(s)** stitch(es)

**skpo** slip 1, knit 1, pass slipped st over

**tbl** through back loop(s)


**tog** together

**WS** wrong side

(.....) **once/twice/3 times** work instructions between brackets the *total* number of times stated

## PATTERN NOTES

Jumper is knitted flat in separate pieces for Back, Front and Sleeves. A Neckband is added to finish.



## INSTRUCTIONS

### BACK

Using 3.75mm needles, cast on 110 (122: 134: 146: 158: 170) sts.

**Rib row 1 (RS)** K2, (p2, k2) to end.

**Rib row 2 (WS)** P2, (k2, p2) to end.

These 2 rows form rib.

Work in rib a further 16 (16: 18: 18: 20: 20) more

rows.

Change to 4mm needles.

Beg with a k row, work 164 (170: 174: 180: 184: 192) rows in st st, ending with a WS row.

### Divide for Back Neck and Shoulders

**Next row (RS)** K37 (42: 47: 52: 57: 62), skpo, turn and work on these 38 (43: 48: 53: 58: 63) sts for first side of neck shaping, leaving unworked sts on holder.

### Shape Right Back Neck and Shoulder

**Next row (WS)** P2tog tbl, p to end. [1 st dec]

**Next row (RS)** K to last 2 sts, skpo. [1 st dec]

Rep last 2 rows once more. [34 (39: 44: 49: 54: 59) sts]

Work 1 row.

Cast off 8 (9: 10: 11: 12: 13) sts at beg of next row and following 2 RS rows. [10 (12: 14: 16: 18: 20) sts]

Work 1 row.

Cast off remaining 10 (12: 14: 16: 18: 20) sts.


### Shape Left Back Neck and Shoulder

With RS facing, place centre 32 (34: 36: 38: 40: 42) sts on st holder, rejoin yarn to remaining sts, k2tog, k to end. [38 (43: 48: 53: 58: 63) sts]

## SCHEMATIC: GARMENT MEASUREMENTS



**Next row (WS)** P to last 2 sts, p2tog. [1 st dec]

**Next row (RS)** K2tog, k to end. [1 st dec]

Rep last 2 rows once more. [34 (39: 44: 49: 54: 59) sts]

Work 2 rows.

Cast off 8 (9: 10: 11: 12: 13) sts at beg of next row and following 2 WS rows. [10 (12: 14: 16: 18: 20) sts]

Work 1 row.

Cast off remaining 10 (12: 14: 16: 18: 20) sts.

### FRONT

Using 3.75mm needles, cast on 110 (122: 134: 146: 158: 170) sts.

**Rib row 1 (RS)** K2, (p2, k2) to end.

**Rib row 2 (WS)** P2, (k2, p2) to end.

These 2 rows form rib.

Work in rib 16 (16: 18: 18: 20: 20) more rows.

Change to 4mm needles.

Beg with a k row, work 148 (154: 158: 164: 168: 176) rows in st st, ending with a WS row.

### Divide for Front Neck

**Next row (RS)** K39 (44: 49: 54: 59: 64), skpo, turn and work on these 40 (45: 50: 55: 60: 65) sts for first side of neck shaping, leaving unworked sts on holder.

### Shape Left Front Neck

**Next row (WS)** Purl.

**Next row (RS)** K to last 2 sts, skpo. [1 st dec]

Rep last 2 rows 5 more times. [34 (39: 44: 49: 54: 59) sts]

Work 9 rows straight.

### Shape Left Shoulder

Cast off 8 (9: 10: 11: 12: 13) sts at beg of next and following 2 RS rows. [10 (12: 14: 16: 18: 20) sts]

Work 1 row.

Cast off remaining 10 (12: 14: 16: 18: 20) sts.

### Shape Right Front Neck

With RS facing, place centre 28 (30: 32: 34: 36: 38) sts on st holder, rejoin yarn to remaining sts, k2tog, k to end. [40 (45: 50: 55: 60: 65) sts]

**Next row (WS)** Purl.

**Next row (RS)** K2tog, k to end. [1 st dec]

Rep last 2 rows 5 more times. [34 (39: 44: 49: 54: 59) sts]

Work 10 rows straight.

### Shape Right Shoulder

Cast off 8 (9: 10: 11: 12: 13) sts at beg of next and following 2 WS rows. [10 (12: 14: 16: 18: 20) sts]

Work 1 row.

Cast off remaining 10 (12: 14: 16: 18: 20) sts.

### SLEEVE (MAKE 2)

Using 3.25mm needles, cast on 54 (58: 66: 70: 78: 82) sts.

**Rib row 1 (RS)** K2, (p2, k2) to end.

**Rib row 2 (WS)** P2, (k2, p2) to end.

These 2 rows form rib.

Work 16 more rows in rib, inc 0 (2: 0: 2: 0: 2) sts evenly across last row. [54 (60: 66: 72: 78: 84) sts]

### Shape Sleeve

Change to 4mm needles.

Starting with a k row, knit 4 rows.

**Inc row (RS)** K4, M1, k to last 4 sts, M1, k4. [2 sts inc]

Work 7 rows.

Rep last 8 rows 13 more times and then rep Inc row once. [84 (90: 96: 102: 108: 114) sts]

Continue straight in st st until Sleeve measures 48 (49: 50: 51: 52: 53)cm from cast-on edge,

ending with a ws row.

### Shape Sleeve Top

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next 18 rows. [12 (18: 24: 30: 36: 42) sts]

Cast off.

### NECKBAND

Join right shoulder seam.

With RS facing and using 3.75mm needles, pick up and knit 22 sts down left front neck, k28 (30: 32: 34: 36: 38) sts from front holder, pick up and knit 22 sts up right front neck, pick up and knit 11 sts down right back neck, k32 (34: 36: 38: 40: 42) sts from back holder, pick up and knit 11 sts up left back neck. [126 (130: 134: 138: 142: 146) sts]

**Rib row 1 (WS)** P2, (k2, p2) to end.

**Rib row 2 (RS)** K2, (p2, k2) to end.

These 2 rows form rib.

Work 5 more rows in rib.

Change to 3.25mm needles.

Work 2 more rows in rib.

Cast off in rib.

### TO FINISH

Join left shoulder and Neckband seam. Place marker 56 (60: 64: 68: 72: 76) rows down from shoulder on each side of both Back and Front. Matching centre of sleeve cast-off edge to shoulder seam, sew in sleeves between sm. Join side and Sleeve seams. Weave in all ends and block to measurements.
